In addition to some questions about the respondent so that we can review demographics and stakeholder groups across the call for evidence, we ask the following questions. All questions below are optional to complete, so respondents can focus on areas that matter to them.

 - We are interested in understanding the quality and availability of professional practical experience, including any barriers or support available.  We consider good professional practical experience to be paid employed work, with effective management and supervision. There is support for individuals so that their work experience completements their academic journey to registration as an architect. Good practical work experience should be in an environment where they are supported and treated fairly so that the requirements of ARB's Code of Conduct and Practice are role-modelled and encouraged. The examples of good practice might be from other sectors beyond architecture. Please share as much relevant detail as possible.
