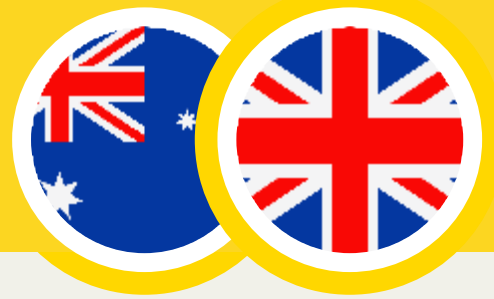


Registration Australia to UK



1 Confirm eligibility

AACA will issue a certificate to qualifying applicants and transmit a copy to ARB.

3 UK Adaptation Assessment

ARB will contact qualifying applicants and inform them of the additional requirements which must be satisfied. This will include the UK Adaptation Assessment, which you must successfully pass to demonstrate that you are able to practise safely and effectively in the UK context and can be admitted to the UK Register of Architects. At this point, you will be required to pay the UK Adaptation Assessment fee of £2950.00.
