

Tomorrow's Architects: Transition Timetable



Autumn 2023

ARB publishes new outcomes and standards for learning providers. Learning providers notify ARB of intention to apply for the accreditation of a new qualification (2 years engagement and assessment process starts). ARB starts visits to assess compliance with the standards.



2024-25

ARB continues to review existing qualifications using risk-based review process with the new Accreditation Committee making decisions relating to continued prescription and any conditions imposed.



January 2025

ARB's Accreditation Committee receives the first set of new qualifications based on the new outcomes for decision, to have students start in September 2025.



September 2026

The final cohort of 'old' Part 2 commence courses. Learning providers will have started mapping an approach for transferring of this cohort mid-qualification to the second year of new model.



September 2027

No new students can commence the 'old' Part 2. All qualifications are now based on the outcomes. Part 1 is no longer prescribed. Prescribed Exam/MRA UK Adaptation Assessment model will be replaced with a new model for assessing equivalent levels of competence.



September 2028

New qualifications to assess the Practice Outcomes are in place.



December 2028

Any old Part 3 courses cease accreditation. All graduating students after 2028 would have qualified through the new structure.



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
